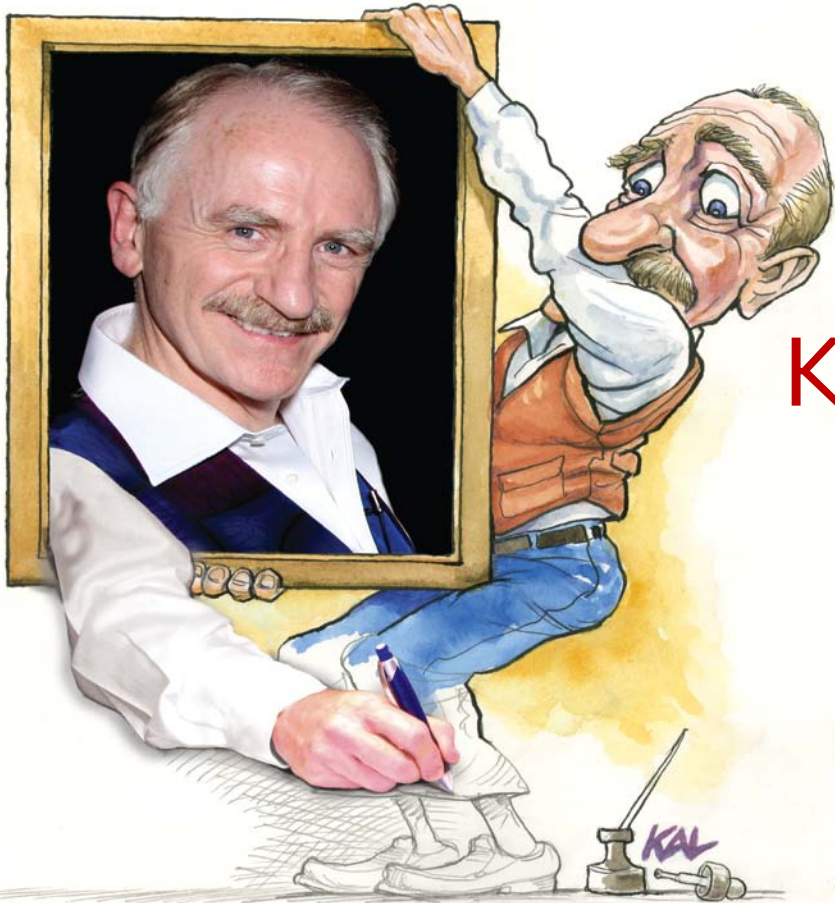

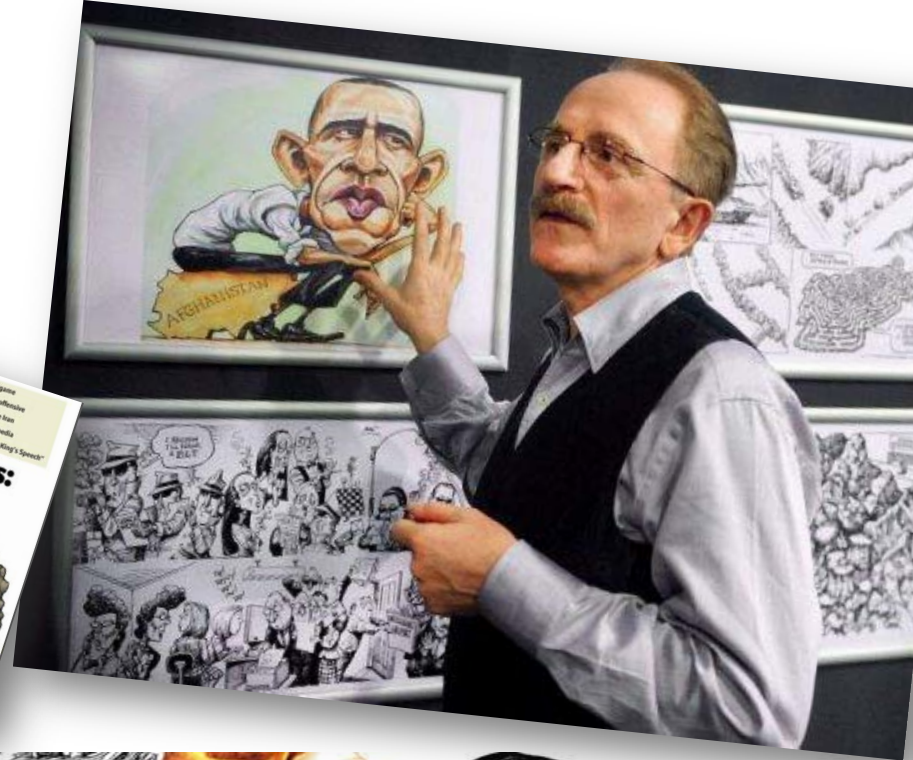

A master of **satirical cartoons**. Celebrated around the world for his **mastery of political commentary**, he is best know for his work each week in **The Economist** newspaper.

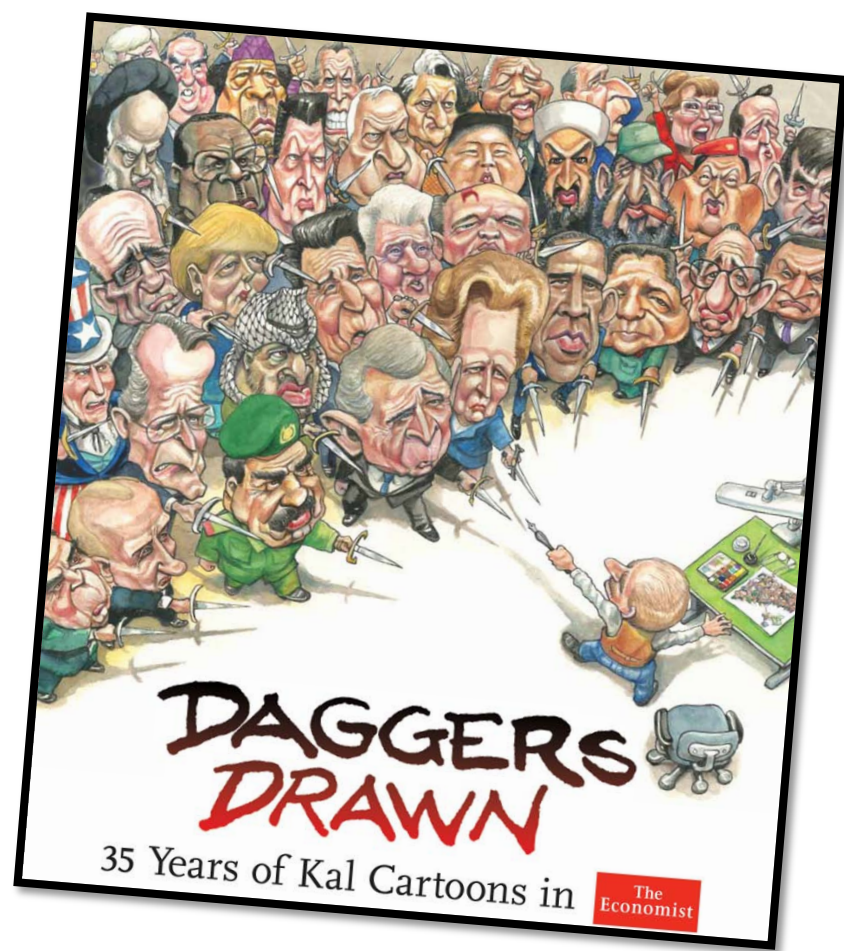

For over 3 decades Kevin “Kal” Kallaugher has **entertained** and **enraged** a global audience with his sharp cartoons and witty covers for *The Economist* magazine. In this large retrospective collection Kal presented **300** of his best works from more than over 4,000 cartoons and 140 covers.

Daggers Drawn was funded entirely through the highly successful “**Kickstarter**” campaign that raised over \$100,000 in just one month and pre-sold 1,800 copies of the book to 46 countries – a measure of the amazing **global following** that Kal enjoys.

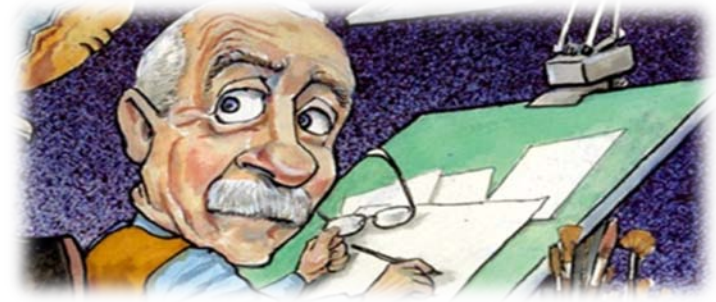

- Returned to the U.S. in 1988 to join *The Baltimore Sun* as its editorial cartoonist and continues to draw for *The Economist*.
- In March 1978, *The Economist* recruited him to become their first resident cartoonist in their 145 year history.
- 10 years working in London as a cartoonist for *The Observer*, *The Sunday Telegraph*, *Today* and *The Mail on Sunday*.
- Past President of the **Association of American Editorial Cartoonists**.
- Past President of the **Cartoonists Rights Network International**.
- Graduated from **Harvard** with honours in Visual and Environmental Studies in 1977.
