About him

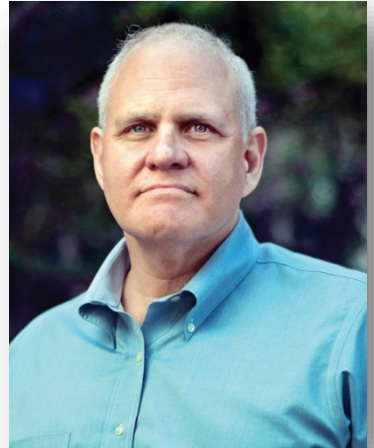
Matthew Friedman is a **leading, internationally renowned global expert** on **modern slavery and human trafficking**. An **award-winning** public speaker, author, filmmaker, and philanthropist, Matthew regularly advises **heads of governments and intelligence agencies**.

As the **founder and CEO** of The Mekong Club, Matthew is considered the **leading catalyst** of the anti-slavery movement in Asia's business sector by captains of industry.

From 2006 to 2012, Matt was the **Regional Project Manager** of the United Nations Inter-Agency Project on Human Trafficking (UNIAP) in Thailand, an inter-agency coordinating body that links the United Nations system with governments and civil society groups in China, Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, Thailand, and Vietnam.

From 1991-2006, Matt worked for the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) in Thailand, Bangladesh and Nepal. For over a decade, he worked passionately to **design** and **manage** both **domestic and regional human trafficking programs**. He also helped **establish** a counter-trafficking regional training centre, participated in resource mobilization, and produced two **award-winning** international films about sex trafficking.

Matt is a **technical advisor** to numerous **governments**. He is frequently cited in the news media, has been invited to speak at major conferences around the world, and is the **author of nine books**.

In 2017, Matthew received the prestigious “**Gold Standard Award For Communicator of the Year**” in Asia for giving more than **800** presentations to **80,000** people including **government leaders** and the **Vatican** on the topic of modern slavery within a five-year period in different countries. Matthew has a **unique** and **powerful speaking style** that **inspires people** to reach their fullest potential.

Each year he is cited at least 40 times in the news media (CNN, Bloomberg, Reuters, Associated Press, the Financial Times, the Economist, etc.) and invited to speak as a keynote at major international conferences around the world.

He has managed and directed **tens of millions of dollars** to major humanitarian portfolios **impacting millions of people** for the World Bank, the U.S. State Department, and the United Nations. His work over the last 30 years of pioneering and managing international anti-human trafficking projects from Nepal, Bangladesh, Thailand and Hong Kong has given him access to many influential networks in different countries throughout the world.

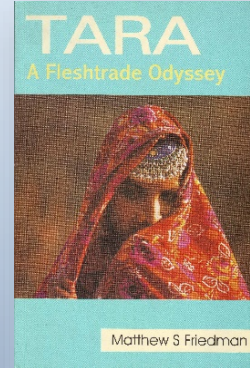
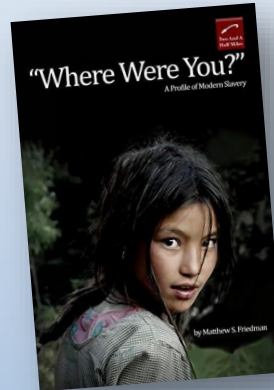
